I very much enjoyed the math video produced by you and your class. This is a very good example of the spirit of inspiring education. I'm making a couple of assumptions here, let me explain...(Well, I guess I'm not really making any assumptions because I AM explaining)

- 1. Engaged learning I could "hear" your students' voices in my head while watching the video. They were explaining how these very RELEVANT pictures were examples of the geometric shapes on the video. Although the video can be used by all grade-level students in PRSD, your students are much more likely to remember the lesson forever as a result of actually being engaged in the process of making the video. They will remember much of this, I expect, from the unique and fun way of presenting the final product. A great review tool that can be viewed from any PLACE, any TIME as a result of the digital format.
- 2. Entrepreneurial Spirit. This is especially true of you and perhaps your students too. A calculated risk that could have failed...and didn't. Even had the video not worked out, there still would have been some good learnings.
- 3. Ethical citizenship. I imagine there was something to learn about taking turns, being patient, having a role on a team.
